MEMORANDUM OF LEASE

RIDER NO. 1

This is a Memorandum of Rider No. 1 dated effective June 1, 2008, to a GATX RAIL Car Net Lease made and entered into as of the 1st day of June, 2008, by and between Stonebriar Commercial Finance LLC, as successor in interest to Greenbrier Leasing Company LLC, which was successor in interest to GATX Corporation (collectively, "Lessor") and Kemira Water Solutions, Inc., as successor interest to Kemira Logistics, Inc.
