Dear Ms. Lee:

I am enclosing 2 counterparts of the document described below to be recorded pursuant to Section 11303, Title 49 of the United States Code.

The document to be recorded, a secondary document, is a Bill of Sale and Release of Security Interest, dated September 23, 1994, by which all right, title and interest in and to the existing equipment covered by the Conditional Sale Agreement Dated as of February 1, 1978 is conveyed to Burlington Northern Railroad Company from Mercantile-Safe Deposit and Trust Company.

The Conditional Sale Agreement Dated as of February 1, 1978, the primary document to which the Bill of Sale and Release of Security Interest is connected, was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on March 31, 1978 and assigned Recordation No. 9300. The related Agreement and Assignment was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on March 31, 1978 and assigned Recordation No. 9300-A.


A general description of the equipment covered by the enclosed Bill of Sale and Release of Security Interest is shown on Exhibits "A" and "B" of said document.

BILL OF SALE AND RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST

WHEREAS, Hayden-Murphy Equipment Company and Transportation Products Company (collectively the "Manufacturers" and individually a "Manufacturer") and Burlington Northern Inc. (the "Railroad"), have entered into a Conditional Sale Agreement dated as of February 1, 1978, ("Agreement No. 78-1A") covering the railroad equipment described in Exhibit "A" hereto (the "No. 78-1A Equipment");

WHEREAS, Agreement No. 78-1A was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission in accordance with Section 11303 of the Interstate Commerce Act on March 3, 1978, and assigned Recordation No. 9262;

WHEREAS, each Manufacturer thereafter assigned its rights under Agreement No. 78-1A and its right, security title and interest to the No. 78-1A Equipment to Mercantile-Safe Deposit and Trust Company (the "Agent"), pursuant to an Agreement and Assignment dated as of February 1, 1978, between the Manufacturers and the Agent; said Agreement and Assignment was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on March 3, 1978, and assigned Recordation No. 9262-A;

WHEREAS, FMC Corporation, ACF Industries, Incorporated, PACCAR INC and DIFCO, Inc. (collectively the "Vendors" and individually a "Vendor") and the Railroad have entered into a Conditional Sale Agreement dated as of February 1, 1978, ("Agreement No. 78-1B" and hereinafter together with Agreement No. 78-1A the "Agreements")

covering the railroad equipment described in Exhibit "B" hereto (the "No. 78-1B Equipment" and hereinafter together with the No. 78-1A Equipment the "Equipment");

WHEREAS, Agreement No. 78-1B was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission in accordance with Section 11303 of the Interstate Commerce Act on March 31, 1978, and assigned Recordation No. 9300;

WHEREAS, each Vendor thereafter assigned its rights under Agreement No. 78-1B and its right, security title and interest to the No. 78-1B Equipment to the Agent, pursuant to an Agreement and Assignment dated as of February 1, 1978, between the Vendors and the Agent; said Agreement and Assignment was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on March 31, 1978, and assigned Recordation No. 9300-A;

WHEREAS, from time to time, notice was given that the road numbers of the No. 78-1B Equipment had been changed in a Consent from the Agent to the Railroad and Statements of New Road Numbers which were filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission, the last of which was filed on February 12, 1991, and assigned Recordation No. 9300-D;

WHEREAS, the Agent has been paid the full indebtedness in respect of the purchase price of the Equipment, together with interest and all other payments as provided in the Agreements, and the Railroad has performed all obligations therein contained.

NOW THEREFORE, the Agent does hereby (a) acknowledge that the Agreements have been satisfied in full; (b) sell, assign, convey

and transfer to the Railroad all its right, security title and interest in the Equipment; and (c) release any security interest it may have had in the Equipment, to the effect that such Equipment shall be transferred to the Railroad free and clear of all liens, charges, liabilities, claims, security interests and encumbrances, of any person whatsoever, created or retained by the Agreements.

This Bill of Sale and Release of Security Interest is simultaneously executed in several counterparts, each of which so executed is deemed to be an original, and such counterparts together constitute but one and the same instrument.

IN WITNESS HEREOF, the Agent has caused its corporate name to be hereunto subscribed and its corporate seal to be duly affixed and attested by its officers thereunto duly authorized this 23rd day of September, 1994.




